The programme includes 23 courses and 5 practical trainings and internships at the leading Russian companies and research centres, mineral resources sector companies, Federal Ministries and Departments.

The programme is taught by leading Saint Petersburg Mining University professors and professionals from the largest companies of the mineral resources and fuel and energy sectors.

The programme aims to foster students' skills in planning, project management, business problem-solving, implementing business ideas, developing unique strategies for company development in a new environment, as well as developing specific IT skills for the digital economy.
